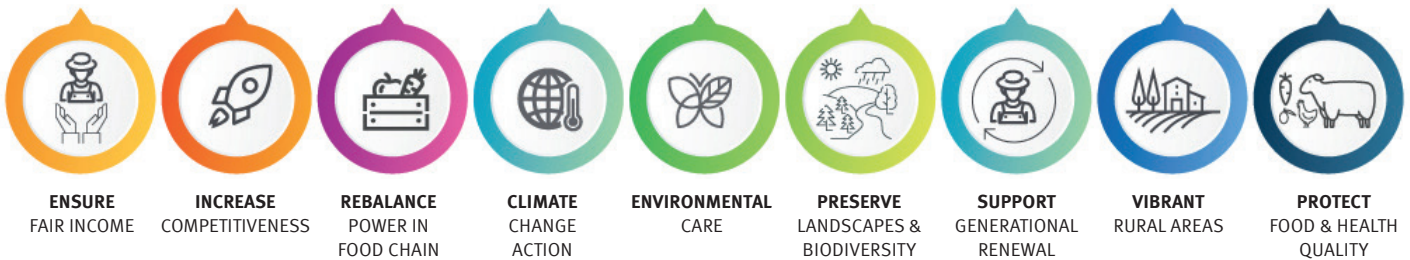


DR. SCHÄR: BIODIVERSITY & THE COMMON AGRICULTURAL POLICY
